


Editable Parent Letters

100th Day Centers

I divide my class into 5 small groups. I have a parent volunteer lead an activity and stay at their assigned center for each rotation. 

100th Day Crown




Each student needs a sentence strip and a copied "100" paper.

Students need to cut out the "100" and glue it to center of the sentence strip.

Students draw 100 things on the "100" side of their crown.

Use the idea chart to draw 10 groups of each shape. (For example, 10 hearts, 10 triangles, 10 swirls, 10 balloons, etc.)

When students are finished, measure their head with the strip and staple the ends to



100 Ways to Exercise



Read a 100th day of school story.

After the story students will make their own 100 book Pass out the 2 copied pages to each child to complete writing sentences on each page. They can add an illustration too.

Students cut the pages into fourths and staple their book.



Fruit Loop Necklace


Each student needs a mat.


Students need to count out 10 fruit loops and place them on a circle.

Students continue counting until all circles have 10 fruit loops each (100 total).

When students have finished counting, give them a string or ribbon to string the necklace.

Help students tie the necklace when finished.







Students will write 4 words for each word family picture to make a total of 100 words.

Hint The words are grouped together by the middle vowel sound starting with <u>a</u>.
