






## Parts of a Friendly Letter



Greeting →

Dear Boys and Girls,

Body →

I have a lot of problems. I know you are all good problem solvers. Will you help me?

Closing →

Love,  
Scruffy

Signature →

## Parts of a Friendly Letter

**Date ~** The date the letter was written.

**Greeting ~** Usually starts with Dear followed by the recipients name and a comma.

**Body ~** The main message of the letter.

**Closing ~** The place to tell who wrote the letter. From, Sincerely, and Love are often used followed by a comma.

**Signature ~** The place the writer signs their name.
