



Word Study Unit: r-controlled ar

families,

week your student is studying words with the phonics skill r-controlled el ar. When the letter a is in the middle of a word, it typically represents short vowel a sound. However, when it is followed by r, the sound is need. In our word study units, we are focusing on students learning an icit phonics skill rather than memorizing a list of words.

Some words that feature this phonics skill are:

arm	star	yarn
park	harp	shark
barn	art	card

Some of these words may be on your student's assessment at the end of the week but there will also be other words that contain this phonics skill.

Spelling patterns for this skill:

 The ar spelling can be used in the middle or at the end of a word: car, far, farm, hard

How to practice at home:

Use a word mapping routine:

- o Choose a word and say it aloud: ex. car
- o Talk about the meaning of the word: Let's get in the cat and drive to the store.
- o Tap the phonemes (sounds) of the word together: /c/-/ar/
- o Write the graphemes (letters) as you sound out the word again: c-

Use multisensory tools:

- o Form words out of playdoh
- o Trace words in sand or rice
- o Create words with alphabet magnets or blocks

Always have your student say the phonemes first, then create the graphem
