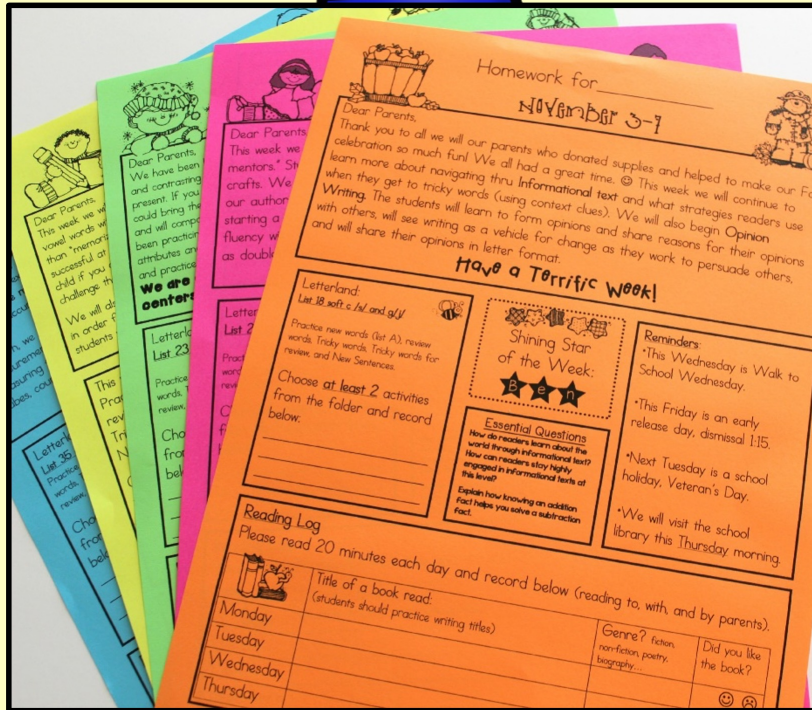

Spelling

- Spread salt on a cookie sheet; spell and read each word with your fingers
- Make flashcards and practice
- Write words in ABC order
- Write a story using words
- Take a practice test
- Any other creative idea...



Reading practice is the most important part of your child's homework! They should read a minimum of 20 minutes per night. This can be to you, with you and sometimes by you. Before reading, try having your child make predictions about the story. While reading, you can discuss the characters, setting, problems and solution of the story. After reading, ask your child to retell the main idea and key details of the story (for non-fiction: retell topic and details).
