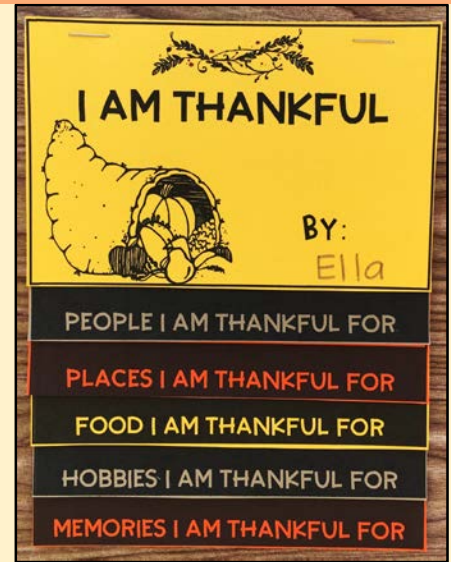

Dear Families,

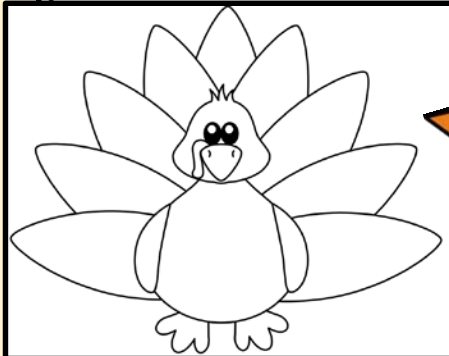
Your child has a very important job to do! They are bringing home a turkey that needs a disguise to help save him/her from getting eaten at Thanksgiving Dinner!
