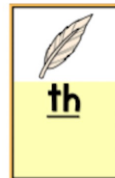

How this sound is formed:

To make the voiceless /th/ sound, put the tip of the tongue between the top and bottom front teeth. Let air escape around the tongue, without vocal cords vibrating.

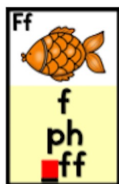
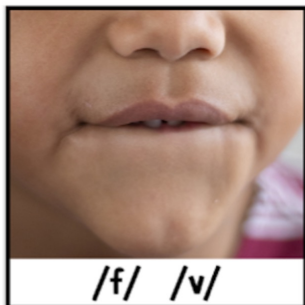

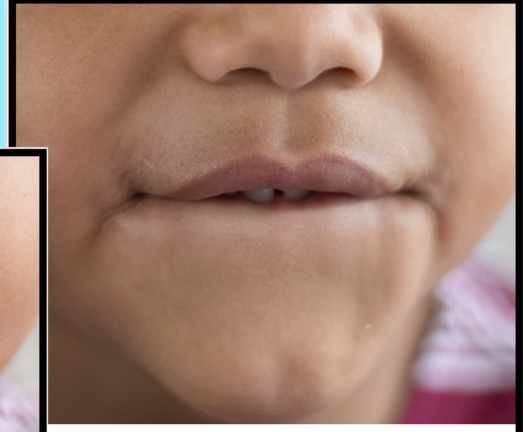
