





About this Resource

The traditional method for learning high frequency words by rote memorization doesn't work for all students. Recent studies now suggest that high frequency words should be taught according to spelling patterns.

The heart word method focuses on irregul frequency words. This method teaches stitle letters and sounds that follow traditions to learn the tricky parts by heart!

For some students, irregular words can be memory after only 1-4 exposures. Struggl need 20+ exposures before the word can recognized.

Permanent Heart Words

There are 82 words in this resource that are perman irregular. The letter-correspondences are unique to to or a small set of words.

Temporary Heart Words

There are a number of words in this resource that ar decodable. However, the difference between a temporary heart word and a flash word varies based on each teacher's phonics scope and sequence and each student's individual phonics skills.

A flash word is considered a heart word if the student has not yet received explicit phonics instruction for the particular letter-sound correspondence. As a result, the letter-sound correspondence would be considered irregular to that student.
